



Maintenance guideline

General Maintenance

Dreen®Ceramica slabs are easy to maintain. Keep the slabs broom-clean and wash with a neutral cleaning agent that leaves no residue and does not require rinsing. DO NOT use:

- Products containing wax, polish, or shine enhancers
- Products containing hydrochloric acid or its derivatives
- Metal scouring pads or any abrasive materials

Rain and Frost

After rain, it's advisable to dry the surface of the slabs with a floor squeegee. In freezing conditions, roofs, roof terraces, and galleries (like bridges and viaducts) can freeze faster and become slippery compared to ground-level terraces. In freezing conditions, it's wise to spread salt preventively. De-icing salt can be used both as a preventive and corrective measure against ice formation or slipperiness. Ensure that there are no salt buildups. The slabs are frost- and salt-resistant.

Periodic Cleaning

For periodic deep cleaning and degreasing, you can use (warm) water with an alkaline-based cleaner and rinse thoroughly. To remove lime deposits, use warm water with a neutral cleaning agent, followed by thorough rinsing with clean water. For large areas, you can use a pressure washer with a brush attachment (medium to hard nylon brushes) and a wet-dry vacuum cleaner with a neutral cleaning agent.

For all given solutions related to cleaning the slabs, it is important to always test the products on a single tile (preferably out of sight) to assess the effect.
